The Program

The mission of the Eugene Area Chamber of Commerce is to serve as a catalytic leader in creating a vibrant and diverse economy that drives economic opportunity and well-being. Businesses led by women are and will continue to have a noticeable impact on the local economy and the chamber believes there is an opportunity to support them.

The Eugene Chamber's Women Business Leaders (WBL) provides the opportunity for participants to meet, advise, support and mentor one another in order to promote the success of women in their professional lives. The program structure includes six monthly educational programs on the second Thursday of every other month.

The Steering Committee

- Members of the WBL Steering Committee guide the development of the WBL program. Specific expectations are as follows:
 - Must be members (or employers are members) of the Eugene Chamber of Commerce.
 - Commit to a two-year term on the Steering Committee.
 - Attend 75% of the Steering Committee meetings throughout the course of one calendar year.
 - Meetings are held once a month, currently virtually. Meeting topics include brainstorming potential event speakers, reviewing past programs, planning future programs, and guiding the future direction of WBL.
 - Introduce new participants and serve as greeters to others at bi-monthly educational programs when needed.
 - Attend at least 2 Business After Hours / Young Professional Network events and 1 annual chamber event (virtually or in person).
 - Help to recruit new attendees to WBL throughout the year.
