Construction: Lane County is home to just over a 1,000 construction firms, employing just over 7,500 people, projected to pay over \$370 million dollars in wages this year. This sector has the largest projected growth of 25% increase in employment between 2017 and 2027.

Healthcare: Lane County is home to just over 1,300 firms, employing over 28,000 people, projected to pay over \$1.35 billion dollars in wages this year. Projected growth for this sector is a 20% increase in employment between 2017 to 2027.

Manufacturing: Lane County is home to about 560 manufacturing companies, employing over 14,300 people, paying over \$751 million dollars in wages. Projected growth for this sector is 12% increase in employment between 2017 and 2027.

Technology: Lane County is home to about 500 tech companies, employing about 3,590 people, paying about \$258 million dollars in wages. This is the second largest sector for projected growth of 25% in employment between 2017 and 2027.

Food and Beverage Production: Lane County is home to about 170 food and beverage companies, employing over 3,800 people paying over \$181 million dollars in wages. Oregon Employment Department projects the sector to grow in employment by 20% in between 2017 and 2027.
